Over the last several years we have donated on average, \$2,500.00 split equally per season to these people in need.

On a National level, we make donations through the UNICO National Foundation to <u>The Jimmy V Foundation</u>, <u>St. Jude's Hospital for Children's Research</u>, <u>Coolies Anemia Foundation</u>, <u>Mental Health Research</u>, and also to the <u>UNICO National Scholarship Fund</u>.




