• Community Service Day: Chuck Russo

Chuck mentioned how this was the best community service day we have had in 15 years! The weather was questionable. It was a cloudy day but no rain, it wasn't hot, or cold so it was a perfect day to have it. We supplied our 7 food pantries with a lot more food than we have ever done in the past. He thanked everyone who showed up to help that day! Those members who were there helped pack food, load food into the cars, and collect food at the doors as well. Some people stayed all day from beginning of the day to the end when it was over. Chuck was extremely grateful to all the members for their support in this event. Chuck thanked the Calvary aka the new young UNICO members who came at 1pm and helped for the rest of the afternoon. This year each food pantry got 2 deliveries/car loads for the day which hasn't been done in years past. St. Agnes church came back 3 times for the day. Chuck mentioned as far as money collected every year the chapter tries to top what was collected the previous year and this year, we collected \$1,255 in cash that's the best we have ever done! Then Carmen Gaita donated an extra \$50 from his Superbowl winnings to make the total collected \$1,305. Chuck then took the money we collected as we don't keep the cash. He went to ShopRite and converted the \$ into Shoprite gift cards to give out to the 7 food pantries. ShopRite gives a 5% discount, so Chuck distributed \$1,367.75 worth of gift cards split for each of the 7 food pantries. Chuck mentioned how people are so generous in donating money when they see what we are collecting for. Angelo's friend, famous rapper RUN DMC, gave \$250 Chuck is always amazed at the generosity of people. Chuck received Thank You cards and notes from St George, Holy Angels, and St. Agnes. Chuck was super happy with how everything turned out and on that note Chuck announced the new Community Service day chair for next year will be Claudine Stefanelli who agreed to take it over.
