# Italian Heritage Photo From the 2023 UNICO Heritage Calendar An inside view of the Roman Colosseum

The Colosseum is an oval amphitheater in the center of the city of Rome. It sat up to 50,000 spectators. It is the largest and most ancient amphitheater ever built. There are 80 entrances but only a few are used today. It was built by 60,000 Jewish slaves. Most events are the time were free to everyone.

They even flooded the colosseum to show their naval boats.

It is believed that around 400,000 died here.
